- MPD (2) 1 Harwood's Altside Too Hot to Handle. Self-masked shaded cream who moved really well. Well balanced throughout in construction and head shape.
- 2 Lunn & Henson Thuja Heaven can Wait (Imp NLD) Lovely black 6-monthold who was finding it all a bit too exciting to concentrate! Good head and eye shape and balanced body.
- PD (5,1)! Hitch's Zendushkas Amarillo. Black masked cream who certainly showed himself off! beautiful movement with lovely forward extension. Good shape throughout with deep chest, rear angulation and ring tail Really looking forward to seeing this one progress BPD.
- 2 Holder's Zendushkas Rolling Stone at Farakushk, litter brother to 1 not so steady on the move but very similar in shape and showing promise.
- 3.Gunn's Katanga God of Thunder
- JD (3,1)1Roper & Moore's Sitana the Kingsman at Temenshu BMG Another promising boy who is well put together with good length of neck and balanced head, good proportions throughout and well-muscled which showed in his movement.
- 2 Gizewska's Shahfoladi Thunderbird (Al) Good shape with lovely head going into long neck and level topline. Just didn't stride out as much as 1.
- YD (2)1. Sitana the Kingsman at Temenshu.
- 2 Parker's Saxonmill Majic Moment at Khatira, another one enjoying his day out! a shame that it was difficult to assess him, as he appears to be well made.

- GD (1) Peek-Matar's Yansukhim's Sherbet Fizz Black with good depth of chest and level topline, well bent stifles and prominent pin bones, balanced head with correct eye shape and low set ears. Shown in good condition which was evident on the move as he strode out.
- PGD (3,1) Newton's Shimalma Jagermeister. Self-masked cream shown in excellent coat. Correct head with good dark eyes that looked past you, long neck going into well balanced body with correct angles making for free striding movement.
- 2 Harwood's Krishan Rainbow Warrior. Brindle shown in good condition with good facial expression, good shoulder and hock placement on the stand.
- MLD (3,1) 1Finch & Hopper's Sitana Lal Toofan at Zinzani BMR Masculine looks and body outline with deep chest and balanced throughout. Excellent muscular and coat condition moved well when he concentrated.
- 2 Lancashire & O'Donnell's Drishaun Pictures of Lily, also shown in extremely good condition. Correct proportions with well angled shoulders and stifles.
- LD (6,1) 1 Davies's Rhajikhan Adrastus, Brindle presented to a high standard. Good head shape and dark eye which looked through you. Well balanced when stacked with level topline which was kept on the move RCC.
- 2 Parsons's Joneca Fire Cracker by Shukriya JW, Gold boy who showed real type, beautiful almond eye and prominent occiput, balanced conformation which was very evident on the move.

- OD 1 Thompson's Ch. Drishaun the Vampire Lily via Gothika JW BMG who filled the eye as soon as he came into the ring. Good head shape into long neck and well-set shoulders with deep chest. Showed in excellent body condition and coat Moved with a style of high order.CC and BIS.
